Job Purpose	The Sustainable Funding Business Partner supports the financial sustainability of our homes by reviewing current fee structures, validating commissioned hours, and producing accurate costings. The role identifies funding gaps and works collaboratively with internal teams and funders to secure fair and sustainable fees.
Key Deliverables	The Sustainable Funding Business Partner will be responsible for reviewing existing fee arrangements across the portfolio and assessing commissioned hours using the Rota and in-house systems. They will compare current funding to today's market rates, identify significant variances between actual costs and current fees, and negotiate fee uplifts with funders where necessary.
